

Loading Custom Image Settings

Overview

Use Leaf® preset image settings to customize image looks and processing settings. Image settings presets contain a group of component presets, including gray balance, develop curve, ICC profiles, grain setting, sharpening, output size and output color.

In Leaf Capture, you can create custom image settings presets to use on your Leaf back when shooting to CF card. This feature is similar to the Leaf Capture 8 “Arrange for Portable” function.

Loading Custom Image Settings to Your Leaf Back

1. In Leaf Capture, on the **Shoot** panel **Session Setup** area, click **Open Image Settings** .

2. Set the desired image settings, and save the preset.

Note: You can create as many presets as you want.

3. Insert a CompactFlash® card into the imaging module, and connect the imaging module to your computer.
4. Connect to the imaging module from Leaf Capture.
5. In the Mac Finder, on the CF card go to **LEAFDM SYS/Leaf_Digital_Magazine_Data/Leaf_Tables/Image_Settings**.

Note: If the folder does not exist, return to portable mode and select a new gray balance. The required folders are created. Return to tethered mode and locate the **Image_Settings** folder.

6. In the Mac Finder, locate the local **Image Settings** folder: from your Home folder, **Pictures/Leaf Images/Leaf Tables/Image Settings**.
7. Copy the custom image settings preset(s) from the local **Image Settings** folder to the **Image Settings** folder on the CF card.
8. On the imaging module, set the image settings by choosing the desired preset from: **Camera > Image > Presets**.

Tip: Formatting the CF card erases the uploaded image settings. To avoid reloading the image settings individually afterward, back up the **LEAFDM SYS** folder on your computer now, and copy the entire folder to the CF card after formatting.
